**WHEREAS**, Cives Steel Company originated in 1952 as the Gouverneur Iron Works, a small operation in Gouverneur New York servicing local miscellaneous and ornamental steel projects, and

**WHEREAS**, now known as Cives Steel Company's Northern Division, it has since grown into a modern steel fabrication facility and is one of the Company's six fabricating facilities in the United States, and

**WHEREAS**, on April 22, 2007 the facility was heavily damaged by fire and approximately 83 employees were out of work, and

**WHEREAS**, the Company has reaffirmed its commitment to the citizens of Gouverneur and the surrounding community by reinvesting its time, energy and finances to repair the damaged facility, and

**WHEREAS**, in October 2007 the facility officially reopened, and

**WHEREAS**, Agency members wish to recognize the extraordinary effort and commitment that Cives has demonstrated in revitalizing their Gouverneur facility,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the St. Lawrence County Industrial Development Agency formally acknowledges and expresses its appreciation to both Cives Steel Company and to its Division President, Ted Totten.
