Donald Peck is St. Lawrence County's Legislative Representative to the Board of the St. Lawrence County Industrial Development Agency.

Don was born and raised in Gouverneur. He became a licensed auctioneer and licensed NYS Real Estate Salesman in 1972. He graduated from SUNY Canton in 1974 and started his own auction business in 1979.

Don was elected Supervisor for the Town of Gouverneur in 1985 and held that position for 21 years. During his tenure as Supervisor, Don assisted in the formation of two water districts and one sewer district. Additionally, he helped establish a microenterprise loan fund for job creation in Gouverneur, worked to consolidate the Village and Town court system, and set up a highway equipment purchasing policy.

Don was elected to the St. Lawrence County Legislature in 2007 and graduated from the Dennis A. Pelletier County Government Institute in 2009. As Legislator, he has served on many committees and search groups, including Chair of the Finance Committee in 2009, Chair of the Highway Committee in 2007 and 2008, and currently serves as Chair of the County's Operations Committee.
